 October or February start dates
 6 in-person events
 Independent study: approx 1 hour/week
 Assessment: 1500 word response to a case study at end of programme

Leadership NPQs - 18 month programme
 October or February start dates
 8 in-person events
 Independent study: approx 1 hour/week
 Assessment: 1500-2500 word response to a case study at end of programme

Leading Behaviour & Culture
 NPQLBC
 For leaders of learning behaviour or pupil well being
 Create a culture of high expectations and climate for learning based on safety, predictability and positivity
 Develop an approach to leading behaviour and culture systems in your setting
 Consider ways of using professional development to bring staff with you

Leading Literacy
 NPQLL
 For those leading literacy in any phase of education e.g. Heads of Literacy, Literacy Coordinators, SLT
 Access the latest literacy development
 Promote high quality literacy for all pupils, across curriculum
 Train & support all subject staff as teachers of literacy; developing language, reading and writing in all areas

Leading Teaching
 NPQLT
 For those leading teaching in a subject, year group, key stage/phase
 Become an excellent leader of teaching
 Explore the science of learning and embed in classroom/context
 Improve pupil outcomes and build skills to lead other staff

Leading Teacher Development
 NPQLTD
 For those leading the development of other educators (new and experienced teachers) e.g. a member of SLT
 Become an expert teacher educator and mentor e.g. for ECTs, ITTs
 Lead change in staff practice to improve pupil outcomes
 Engage with best evidence and effect professional development and implementation

Special Educational Needs
 NPQ SEND
 For those leading SEND across the school, and school leaders
 Co-ordinate special educational needs (SEN) provision throughout your school
 Work alongside other leaders to build a school culture in which pupils with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) can participate meaningfully in the full life of the school, achieve ambitious outcomes and make successful transitions to their next steps

Early Years Leadership
 NPQEY
 For Managers of PVI, Heads, EYFS Leaders, Childminders
 Engage with best evidence and practice in key areas of EYFS; create evidence-based shared direction
 Develop curriculum, use of referrals and interventions, promote safety and positivity
 Build deeper understanding of role, context, support for staff and children

Senior Leadership
 NPQSL
 For senior leaders with cross-school responsibilities
 Learn from leadership experts and best evidence for effective leadership
 Ensure curriculum meets individual needs, working with parents/carers
 Support staff development; embed systems and accountability

Headship
 NPQH
 For those leading a school e.g. Head Teachers, Heads of School
 Transform pupils' knowledge, capabilities and beliefs about learning with rich, diverse curriculum
 Drive change through insight and practice; make and act upon evidence-informed decision
 Establish financial, human and educational resource management; working together supporting individuals' needs

Executive Leadership
 NPQEL
 For those leading several schools eg Executive Heads or school trust CEO
 Excel as an Executive School Leader
 Learn from experts and the best available evidence
 Train to own timetable, complete the programme over time

Leading Primary Mathematics
 NPQLPM
 For those leading maths across a primary key-stage or school
 Build skills, confidence and knowledge to implement a detailed, coherent mathematics curriculum
 Develop pupils' logical thinking and reasoning, automaticity, fluency and problem solving skills, promoting confidence and academic progress in mathematics throughout your setting
 Identify key elements of primary pupils' mathematical learning trajectories; access expertise and networks to explore mathematical approaches with other maths leaders
