



Introduction

All schools that offer a statutory induction are required to have an Appropriate Body (AB) for their Early Career Teachers (ECTs). The new Odyssey Teaching School Hub Appropriate Body will support schools and ECTs to meet the new statutory guidance. Through moderation, quality assurance and fidelity checks we will work collaboratively with schools to ensure that ECTs are fairly and consistently assessed.

Odyssey Teaching School Hub provides Appropriate Body services to meet the needs across The Forest of Dean, Gloucester and Tewkesbury. We offer Appropriate Body services to all schools with a specialty in Secondary provision. For schools in Cheltenham, Stroud and the Cotswolds AB services are provided by Balcarras Teaching School Hub who can be contacted using: jmn@balcarras.gloucs.sch.uk.

Core Package

- Registering your ECTs with the Teacher Regulation Agency (TRA).
- Receiving, reading and registering assessment forms.
- Giving advice and guidance on statutory guidance for the ECF.
- Ensuring that training and support provided by the school (or provider) meets the ECF and the fidelity checks.
- ECF Induction Handbook
- Email reminders for key actions and deadlines.
- Dedicated online and telephone advice and support for Induction Tutors.
- Monitoring visits and feedback along side an annual QA process.
- Clear and supportive advice where ECTs are at risk of failure.
- Access to ECT Manager which is a clear and secure paperless system for ECT registration, assessments and induction resources.
- Training to support the use of ECT Manager within schools.

- Option 1** Full Induction Programme with Gloucestershire ECT Programme and AB Service with Odyssey Teaching School, Hub.
£250 per ECT per Cohort with a maximum of £1000 per school
- Option 2** Full Induction Programme through a another provider and Appropriate Body Service with Odyssey Teaching School Hub.
£300 per ECT per cohort with a maximum of £1200 per school
- Option 3** UCL Core Induction Programme and Appropriate Body Service with Odyssey Teaching School Hub.
£300 per ECT per cohort with a maximum of £1200 per school
Plus £700 per school for the programme of fidelity checks.
In addition, if a school based programme is deemed as not having fidelity to the ECF, additional checks and support visits may be needed. These will be charged at a rate of £350 per day.
- Option 4** OTHER Core Induction Programme and Appropriate Body Service with Odyssey Teaching School Hub.
£300 per ECT per cohort with a maximum of £1200 per school
Plus £1000 per school for the programme of fidelity checks.
In addition, if a school based programme is deemed as not having fidelity to the ECF, additional checks and support visits may be needed. These will be charged at a rate of £350 per day.
- Option 5** School Led Induction Programme and Appropriate Body Service with Odyssey Teaching School Hub.
£300 per ECT per cohort with a maximum of £1200 per school
Plus £3000 per school for the programme fidelity checks.
In addition, if a school based programme is deemed as not having fidelity to the ECF, additional checks and support visits may be needed. These will be charged at a rate of £350 per day.

The increase in price for Options 3 and 4 accounts for the fidelity check before the start of the induction period by the AB which will include ensuring the materials and sessions are in line with the statutory guidance for induction and meet the ECF induction programme standards. All prices are subject to VAT where applicable. Charges will be prorated per term for ECTs starting in Terms 2 or 3.

The Odyssey TSH AB is committed to ensuring value for money and not charging more than the cost of supplying this service. Therefore, the pricing for this service will be revised annually and any savings or additional costs made due to uptake will be passed on to schools.
